



South Launceston Football Club – Junior Body **Code of Conduct – 2011**

1. Under no circumstances will a parent be allowed to make any remarks to an umpire. If a parent breaks this rule, their child will be punished due to your indiscretion and will miss the following 4 games or as directed by the Junior Committee. The SLFC feel very strongly on this point.
2. Respect your team mates and opponents.
3. Respect the umpire's decision and don't argue. (They don't change their mind.)
4. No Swearing under any circumstances.
5. Listen when coaches are speaking and follow instructions straight away.
6. Training is compulsory as directed by the coach.
7. Train hard and always give your best.
8. Don't be late for training or games – arrive at designated times as directed by your coach, as team details must be provided to Match Managers 45 minutes prior to kick off. A replacement will be allocated to your spot if you are not at the ground prior to the time notified by your coach as directed by the SLFC Junior Committee.
9. The Coach's decision is final.
10. Mouth guards must be worn during games.
11. Be prepared to try new things.
12. Respect club property.
13. These rules are put into place so everyone knows what behaviour is required of them during the season.
14. Failure to follow these rules will result in discipline depending on the severity. This could range from a warning to sitting out time at training or not being selected for the next game.
